

EEU PARKING OPTIONS

Please read carefully. The University of WA strictly enforces its parking policies.

For parents dropping off or picking up a child, there are 2 options:

1. Gratis 30 Minute Load Zone Permit

- Stop at the gatehouse, identify yourself as an EEU parent and request a 30-minute load zone permit.
- You may park for **up to 30 minutes** in 1) any *Unrestricted* parking area in S-1 (an *unrestricted* area is one without a sign limiting parking to a specific type of permit holder), 2) a designated load zone, west of the CHDD, 3) in the S-1 parking area and 4) in the new EEU Parking area. The new EEU Parking is located by the basketball court.
- With this permit, and *during times when buses are not arriving to load or unload children*, you may park for *up to 30 minutes* in the bus load zone. (**See restricted times below.**)
- During student load/unload times, *if there is room*, you may stop at the red curb in the traffic circle in front of the bus load zone (*there is room for a few cars at a time*). Do not stop in the bus load zone in front of the EEU during times when buses are arriving or loading and unloading children. The buses are required to park bumper-to-bumper during loading and unloading, for the children's safety. There may be 10-12 buses during these times:

8:30 – 9:15 10:45 – 11:15 12:00 – 1:15 2:00 – 3:15

- **Do not leave your car at any time in the traffic circle (RED ZONE).** You may be required to move your car to allow an emergency vehicle or bus to pass.

2. 30 Minutes or Less Drive-Through Permit

This option has been discontinued by Parking Services. Quarterly drive-through permits are no longer available. We are working with them to try to get this option reinstated.

Do not stop your car in the bus load zone during these hours:

8:30 – 9:15 10:45 – 11:15 12:00 – 1:15 2:00 – 3:15

To park longer than 30 minutes, or when not dropping off or picking up a child, see other side.

Parking Permit with Partial Refund

- Stop at the gatehouse, purchase a parking permit (\$10.00) and leave it on the dash of your car. (For meetings that begin at 4 p.m. or later, the cost is \$4.00.)
- EEU parents may request parking in S-1, close to the building.
- If your stay is less than 4 hours, stop at the gatehouse as you leave for a partial refund. See refund schedule below:

<u>Length of Stay</u>	<u>Refund</u>
0-30 minutes	\$9.00
30 min – 1 hour	\$7.00
1 – 2 hrs	\$4.00
2 – 3 hrs	\$2.00
3 – 4 hrs	\$1.00

After 4 p.m. weekdays and until 12 noon Saturdays the cost is \$4.00 upon entry.

Parking Permit with a Full Refund *(Please use the full refund method for all parent-teacher conferences, such as IEP and IFSP, and at other times when needed.)*

- Buy a \$10.00 parking permit at the gatehouse and leave it on the dashboard so it is readable from the outside.
- EEU parents may request parking in S-1, close to the building.
- Pick up a validation coupon at the Front Office or from your child's teacher before returning to your car.
- At your car, place the coupon on the back of your parking permit.
- Present the validated permit to the traffic guide as you leave. EEU will be charged and you will receive a full refund. The refund will only be issued on the date that the permit was issued.

EEU welcomes your participation in your child's classroom and in parent activities and does not want the cost of parking to limit your participation. Contact the Admissions office (Kate Ahern) or School Secretary (Zee Yilma) at (206) 543-4011 regarding questions or concerns about parking.

Remember, do not stop your car in the bus load zone during these hours:

8:30 – 9:15 10:45 – 11:15 12:00 – 1:15 2:00 – 3:15

At other times, with either a Drive-Through, 30-minute Child Drop-off or Parking permit, you may park in the bus load zone for up to 30 minutes.

You may stop for pick-up or drop-off at painted curb in the traffic circle, if there is room, but do not leave your car.

2. **30 Minutes or Less Drive-Through Permit**

You can avoid stopping at the gatehouse if you get a quarterly drive-through permit (see below).

- Go to the main Parking Services Office, (3901 University Way N.E. 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday – Friday) to pick up a free permit at the beginning of each quarter. Identify yourself as an EEU parent and bring license plate numbers of any vehicles you may use when dropping off your child.
- Place the permit on the lower center of your front windshield. The permit shows that you have a child attending the EEU. *With this permit, you do not need to stop at the gatehouse* when you come to drop off or pick up your child, if you are staying for less than 30 minutes.
- With a drive-through permit, follow the same policies as above for the load zone permit.
